
Financial difficulties experienced by boarding school graduates and children from families with difficult life circumstances are the main reason why a child does not continue his education after school or does not finish it even after entering a vocational school or college. In addition, in the first year after leaving the boarding school, graduates face problems related to budget planning, medical care, organization of life, food and free time, interaction with society, etc.

Education is expensive. Even if you managed to get on the budget, living in another city, paying for a hostel, buying groceries, spending on practical classes - all this requires a lot of FINANCE. Not every student can use the resources of his family - simply because the parents themselves cannot afford to support a child. Especially when it is a family in difficult life circumstances.

A family in difficult life circumstances is a family that cannot solve its own problems and needs help from the state or specialists.

These children are the ones who need outside help, because the closest people, their parents, do not have the opportunity or desire to create appropriate conditions for their upbringing, development, education and treatment. A full-scale war worsened the financial and psychological situation of this vulnerable category of people many times.

One of the effective forms of helping such children is the "Successful Start" project. Information about project participants in the 2022/23 and 2023/24 academic years is given in the diagram:



Participation in the project contributes to the educational process. Thanks to the help of our benefactors, all participants received financial support - a scholarship - during the year. Intended use: purchase of products, medicines, office supplies, payment for internet, telephone and transport costs. It should be noted that class teachers and student teachers note the motivational impact of detdom.info support on academic success and class attendance.

During the training, the children received medical care within the framework of the "Right to Health" project, psychological help and support from older volunteer friends.

Successful mastering of the profession requires the completion of industrial practice. Unfortunately, educational institutions are not allocated funds for such needs. That is, the purchase of fuel, products, uniforms, even books and manuals falls on the shoulders of the students themselves. In the 2022-23 academic year, the purchase of teaching materials was paid for, sports equipment was handed over, a generator and a barbecue were purchased for the Skvyr Higher Vocational School. Thanks to such help, the students of this

institution had the opportunity to continue learning their profession even in the event of a power shortages. The generator provided the production shops with light, and the barbecue became a substitute for electric stoves.

In the 2023-24 academic year, Yaroslav K. desperately needed a working tool for production practice - a set of end heads. The boy received it and now has the opportunity not only to practice in classes at the school, but also to work part-time at the service station.

Separately, we would like to mention our cooperation within the framework of this project with the German charitable organization "Sai Care Stiftung". Thanks to their help, 24 project participants have full funding, 18 participants were provided with clothes and shoes, the laboratory-kitchen of the Skvyrskyi Higher Vocational School received as a gift new professional meat grinders, a multi-grinder, a dough mixer, a halogen oven, an electric grill, blenders, mixers, kitchen scales and much more. This will allow not only the participants of the "Successful Start" project, but also all children who are studying to be cooks, to master modern technology and acquire professional skills in the future profession.

We would also like to separately thank the participants of the Ukrainian Premier Football League, who donated sports equipment for the Skvyr school. After all, sports develop willpower and motivate the desire to win in all spheres of activity, and this is very important for our children.

Thank you to everyone who responded to urgent needs. For example, at the beginning of the 23-24 academic year, some children came to educational institutions without money or food. The accrual of the detdom.info scholarship and the state scholarship requires the collection and

submission of documents, and this takes some time. Therefore, upon learning that children attend classes hungry, Andrii Dovhal and the Canadian company "Progressive Automations" immediately provided assistance for the purchase of food for such children.

We do not forget about pleasant surprises and means of motivation that affect learning. On the eve of New Year's holidays, children were given sweet gifts by our confectioner volunteers. At the end of the 2022-23 academic year, the 11 best participants of the project were specially recognized - they were bought clothes and shoes according to their requests, and at the end of the 2023-24 semester, the five best participants received mobile phones, Bluetooth headphones, music speakers and a smart watch as a gift.



entering a family-type orphanage from an institution or from a family where the parents neglected their direct responsibilities, the child needs additional attention from the parents-educators, teachers, and social services. After all, the level of knowledge of children from an institutional environment is usually lower than that of their peers. Therefore, the project helps parents-caregivers to solve these problems.

Tutoring takes place in various subjects: English, Ukrainian, mathematics, history of Ukraine, junior school. We especially focus on graduates who are preparing to take a multi-subject test.

To evaluate the results of the project, at the beginning of the academic year, we fix the school score for each subject for which the student begins additional training. At the end of the year, this score is checked. Also, tutors, children and parents-educators set conditional scores at the beginning and at the end of training. According to the results of the 2022-23 academic year, an average figure was derived, according to which the level of knowledge increased by 2.1 points on average.

In addition, 4 children were preparing for the multi-subject test. Three of them became students of higher educational institutions, and one became a college student:

- Elsa (DBST Bondar), Belotserkiv Agrarian University (Faculty of Economics);
- Oleksandra (DBST Shevchenko), Kropyvnytskyi University of Physical Education and Sports (Faculty of Physical Culture and Sports);
- Anastasia (DBST Chekomudian), Rivne Humanitarian University (Faculty of Pedagogy);
- Danylo (DBST Chekomudian), Rivne Motor College (faculty of international transportation).

Not every subject teacher can find an approach to DBST pupils, because they are orphans, and they have a certain traumatic experience and it is necessary to make a lot of effort in order to build a trusting relationship, and only then get a result. For example, in DBST Vedernikov, Nikita had something wrong with mathematics. They decided to try to change the teacher, took a young active boy, and oh! miracle! he found an approach to it. The boy is interested in the subject and is already showing good results.

"I want to learn" project has been implemented since 2021, it provides additional classes (tutoring) in school subjects for DBST students (foster families).

A family is needed for the comprehensive and harmonious development of a child. Skills and abilities necessary for successful socialization are formed in the family. Only the family is the best environment for raising and developing a child. Therefore, a family-type orphanage is the most effective form of placement for an orphan child.



Social and educational project "Educational HUB"



The educational process in the de-occupied territories

The project provides assistance to school graduates (teenagers from de-occupied, occupied and front-line territories) in war conditions to prepare well for admission to educational institutions of Ukraine and to provide them with equal access to quality education.

In February 2023, after the de-occupation of Kherson Oblast, the detdom.info team travelled to Kherson Oblast to study the needs of children in local territorial communities. The restoration of the educational process in face-to-face form was practically impossible.

The local authorities tried to establish distance education for children with affordable means. The lack of stable electricity supply, heat, mobile communication, and the Internet complicated this process. After holding meetings and consultations with specialized employees of executive committees of territorial communities, it was decided to focus specifically on helping school graduates who plan to continue their studies.

"FASTFORWARD" LLC (educational company ZNO.UA) was identified as the partner of the project for conducting online courses on preparing children for NMT. Classes are held on the company's platform by qualified and experienced teachers.

Project activities in the 2022-2023 academic year

In the 2022-2023 academic year, the "Educational HUB" project covered 3 de-occupied and front-line communities in the territory of the Kherson region, namely:

- √ Novovorontsov settlement territorial community;
- √ Novoaleksandrivska rural territorial community;
- √ Vysokopilsk settlement territorial community.

Three children from the occupied territories of the Kherson region also took part in the project. After the conditions for admission to higher education institutions for residents of temporarily occupied territories were announced, where it was determined that they could enter based on the results of interviews and without passing the NMT, these children stopped participating in the project.

During February 2023, groups of students were formed to conduct online classes to prepare for the national multi-subject test in the following subjects:

- √ Ukrainian language – 17 participants;
- √ mathematics – 21 participants;
- √ history of Ukraine - 12 participants.


There are 50 student cities in total.

In addition, project participant Pavlo Ts. (a conscript military serviceman) took individual classes in mathematics.

Obtained project results:

Math. Fifteen students, who showed good results, were tested according to the results of their studies. For example, Diana F. received 110 points on the trial test at the beginning, and 152 in June. The average plus according to the trial testing results was 20 points.

Ukrainian language. Trial testing was conducted a few weeks before the NMT, the children showed a good result. For example, Olena S. and Victoria S. provided 77% of the correct answers. The average percentage of correct answers was 69.5%.

History of Ukraine. At the end of the course, seven students were tested, who showed excellent results. For example, Kyrylo L. received 100 points in the trial testing at the beginning, and 168 in June. The average score gains according to the trial testing results was 53 points.

Summing up together with the team, after conducting a survey of children, parents and teachers, the results of the project were evaluated as good. Children received the necessary knowledge within their level and emotional state.

91% of children answered that they are "well" or "very well" prepared for taking the NMT, they are confident in their knowledge, and the procedure of taking the entrance exams does not scare them.

On top of this project participants were supplied with notebooks and prime dresses.

Project activities in the 2023-2024 academic year (I semester)

Online math lesson

In the autumn of 2023, 3 more communities of the Kherson region joined the project - Mylivska, Beryslavska and Veliko-Olexandrivska, as well as the Chuguiev community of the Kharkiv region. In total, the project covers 7 communities.

23 project participants are 11 grade pupils from 6 territorial communities of the Kherson region and one participant from the occupied territory started online classes in mathematics in October. The course will last 8 months.

Feedback from participants regarding learning in the 1st block of the mathematics course:

Snizhana Sh.: "I am satisfied with the learning process. Maryana (the teacher) explains the material very well. I like the fact that in one lesson we not only go through the theory, but also a lot of practice, which is very useful. This course is useful for me in preparation for NMT."

Anastasia L.: "I am satisfied with the results and presentation of the material, this course helps me to remember and learn what I missed in the 8th-9th grade due to the war and the pandemic, it also allows me to pass the NMT well, many thanks to the organizers!"

In December 2023, an educational group for preparation for the Ukrainian language was formed.

These are 15 graduates of the year 2023/24. from schools in the Kherson and Kharkiv regions (de-occupied and front-line territories). The start of the online Ukrainian language course for project participants will begin in January 2024 and will last 4 months (2 blocks of 2 months each).

"Family Needs Help" program



Food aid to the Bondarets family

The activities of detdom.info are focused on helping children and families who, usually due to difficult life circumstances, need help and support. In addition, these are large families, family-type children's homes (DBST). Today, most of these families have lost the ability to provide for their families even at the minimum level that existed before the war, and some even found themselves on the verge of poverty. Families that have suffered especially as a result of the war, lost their homes and moved to other cities - these are internally displaced families - are in need of urgent help now. Therefore, one of the directions of our work is to provide such families with food kits, medicines, baby food, hygiene and cleaning

products, bed linen, blankets, dishes, generators, etc.

In 2023, we were in constant contact with benefactors Silvia and Anatol, Yuri and Kristina, Andriy Dovhal, Maria Kornienko from Denmark, and the Canadian company Progressive Automations.

Especially inspiring are the cases when help is needed urgently and our benefactors respond to such requests just as urgently. Yes, the social worker of the Dolyna city center of social services turned to us for help. A family from the Kherson region, a man with elderly parents and a daughter, moved to the city of Dolynsk after the explosion of the Kakhovskaya HPP. People had nothing at all with them, only a shoulder bag. Any help would be appreciated. And thanks to the philanthropist Andriy Dovhal, the family received food, household chemicals, and hygiene products.

In 2023, our team provided assistance to 172 families, which is approximately 800 children. From our foster families, we receive not only requests for help, but also sincere words of gratitude. In these words, the mother-educator of the Molyar family-type orphanage expressed her gratitude: "Thank you very much for the gifts, care and, most importantly, the holiday spirit for our children, especially in such a difficult time for Ukraine. May God protect you and your families, well-being and prosperity." See Appendix 1 for a list of families that received assistance.

Project "Right to Health"

Quality medical services for children



DBST Peresenchuk "Consultation of an ophthalmologist"

The "Right to Health" project provides for the provision of diagnostic, medical, preventive and consultation assistance to orphans and children left without parental care, graduates of boarding schools, children from low-income families and family-type orphanages, and, if possible, we provide medical assistance to our defenders who protect Ukraine today.

During the course of the project, we have established partnership relationships with doctors and medical clinics of various profiles. Thanks to such cooperation, during 2023, 63 children and our defender received 81 high-quality medical services for free, among them:

- 35 dental services;
- 21 ophthalmological consultations;
- 1 orthopedic consultation;
- 1 neurologist consultation;
- 4 consultations of an ENT specialist;
- 11 laboratory studies (submission of analyses);
- 1 gynecologist consultation;
- 1 pediatrician consultation;
- 3 dermatologist consultations;
- 2 ultrasound diagnostics;
- 3 CT diagnostics;
- 1 vocal therapist consultation and further treatment;
- 1 proctologist consultation.

17 medical institutions are involved in the project, and in 2023, 9 medical institutions were added, which became our partners.

Dental and vision problems remain the most frequent requests of the project. We especially thank the Aylaz ophthalmological center, the MamaDentist dental clinic and the DD Clinic, the Nikolab medical laboratory, for their constant cooperation.

We sincerely thank the new partners who willingly agreed to cooperate with us: 3D Planmeca Diagnostics, Dentaderm Dental Clinic, Professor Lyubchenko Clinic, Bogomolets Clinic, Spizhenko Clinic, Kyiv Regional Clinical Hospital, Center for Neurodiagnostics, Institute of Orthopedics and Traumatology of the National Academy of Medical Sciences of Ukraine, Medeira Clinic.

Project "Our defenders" - Unit detdom.info

The second year of the war and the second year of support for graduates of boarding schools and family-type orphanages who went to defend the Motherland. During the year, the number of defenders increased, but the most important thing is that all defenders are alive! At the end of the year, the organization was in contact with 31 boys who are doing military service under a contract and are in units involved in active military operations. Some of them have an officer rank or are students of higher military educational institutions.

The needs of our defenders in 2023 have changed. Military personnel who had just signed a contract and were not yet provided with everything they needed material assistance. The boys increasingly needed psychological help, legal advice, communication, and moral support. For many of them, detdom.info volunteers are the only close people, they have no other family. Defenders who were seriously injured needed special support. At the end of the year, one of the defenders continues treatment (requires a number of appropriate operations to restore his arm), the second was deemed unfit and received disability, and the third has recovered and is already continuing his service in the ranks of the border guards.

Taking into account the changing needs, the project in 2023 focused more on an individual approach and contact with each of the boys, especially those who were in hospitals and needed constant support. We are proud of each of them! Material support was provided thanks to benefactors who supported the project financially. Thus, Mykhailo Ch. was purchased AK stores and a winter sleeping bag; Valery V. – winter uniform; drugs were purchased for Ivan B. for another operation.

In addition, Pavlo Ts. received assistance within the social and educational project "Educational HUB" and assistance with admission to a higher educational institution.

We are infinitely grateful to those defenders who gave their lives and health defending our Motherland.

The volunteer group to which we gave the title of "the most stable" is "Kmytov's navigators". It was this group that did not stop visiting children during the pandemic and continues its work during the war. The group was created in 2017, and the main composition of volunteers has not changed much.

"It feels like just yesterday I went to them as a volunteer for the first time at the age of 19, and now I'm 25. Time really flies, and it's interesting to watch how children grow and change right before our eyes," recalls Anastasia, one of the curators of the volunteer groups

It is worth noting that all this time the group visited the children with interesting projects and programs aimed at their personal development. This year is no exception. During the year, 5 trips were made. Together with the children, the volunteers mastered financial literacy, self-defense, the basics of medical care, held various master classes, watched and discussed modern movies together, and many other interesting things. Thanks to the long-term communication between the children and the volunteers, a trusting relationship has developed, it is this factor that contributes to deep and strong relationships.

From 30.09-05.10 detdom.info coordinators were trained in Poland on a studio visit, where they studied the experience of supporting families and adoptive families in Poland. This event was implemented with the support of UNICEF. Representatives of social service centers, children's services and public organizations were invited from Ukraine.

Project financing

Thanks to the open posting of verified information on detdom.info, thousands of volunteers and benefactors can quickly and directly help children. According to our calculations, the amount of assistance to children and families known to us is only 10% of the actual overall results of the project. About 90% of the assistance is outside of our accounting.

In 2023, the total amount of aid to children through detdom.info efforts known to us is **UAH 5,737,282**.
