


MEMORABLE HIGHLIGHTS OF 2024

“THE RIGHT TO HEALTH” PROJECT

Health is the most important value for a child and an adult



"The Right to Health" is a social project aimed primarily at treating and supporting the health of children from family-type orphanages, children from foster families, boarding schools, children returned from occupation etc.

The indifference of biological parents, hostilities, prolonged stay under occupation, significant deterioration of living conditions and limited access to medical services bring about serious changes in the health of children and lead to the development of chronic diseases that require immediate treatment.

Unfortunately state medical care is not perfect. As before, it is virtually impossible to receive free dental services, high-quality examinations (MRI, CT), conduct a wide and meaningful range of tests, and receive consultations from narrowly specialized specialists.

And here our project comes to the rescue: we help to sort out complaints, coordinate potential patients to highly professional doctors in our partner clinics and help them to choose the shortest and most effective path for the patient to treatment and recovery.

Thanks to partner medical centers, 32 children received free quality medical services in 2024, 9 of them were children returned from the occupation. More than 59 visits were made and 42 consultations were provided by narrow-profile specialists, including:

- 37 dental services
- 3 MRI services
- 1 ultrasound service
- 1 ENMG service
- 1 laboratory testing service
- 1 pediatrician consultation
- 5 ophthalmologist consultations
- 6 otolaryngologist consultations
- 2 neurologist consultations
- 1 proctologist consultation

In 2024 18 medical institutions accepted patients under our care.

“SUCCESSFUL START” PROJECT




The modern world is changing rapidly and today's teenagers are not just observers but active participants in these changes. They are our future and their participation already determines what this future will be like. That is why most of detdom.info's projects are aimed at helping this category of children. The "Successful Start" project, which started in 2020 and has provided support to more than 300 children during this time, is no exception. The teenagers cared for by the "Successful Start" project are children with difficult fates: orphans, young people from low-income families, large families and graduates of boarding schools.

The financial difficulties experienced by boarding school graduates and children from families with difficult life circumstances are the main reason why a child does not continue their education after school or does not complete it even after entering a vocational school or college. In addition, in the first year after leaving boarding school, graduates face problems related to budget planning, medical care, organization of life, nutrition and free time, interaction with society etc.

Education is expensive. Even if you managed to enroll on a state budget financed tuition, living in another city, paying for a dormitory, buying groceries, spending on practical classes - all of this requires considerable finances. Not every student can use their family's resources - simply because the parents themselves cannot afford to support the child. Especially when it is a family in difficult life circumstances.

One of the effective forms of assistance to such children is the "Successful Start" Project. Information about the project participants is presented in the diagram:



During participation in the project, all participants receive material support - a scholarship of 1,000 UAH/month. The total amount of scholarships support to all participants in 2024 was 1,068,000 UAH. The scholarship has a specific purpose. With these funds, the participants can buy food, medicines, pay for the telephone and Internet and spend them on transportation. In addition, the participants received the following material and technical support:

It should be noted that personal contact with each participant is of great importance for the child's success in the project because most of them do not have a close adult with whom they can consult, communicate and receive support. Our participants are vulnerable teenagers, insecure who are frightened by the unknown of adult life and which is often not accompanied by the presence of an adult mentor. How to study well, how to gain the favor of classmates, how to learn to contact/serve yourself, how not to succumb to easy offers? All these questions become a real knot for them that cannot be untied, so we are in constant contact with each of them. We also pay attention to the physical health of children, as part of the "Right to Health" project, assistance was provided to 3 project participants during 2024.

Production practice is an integral part of the learning process for many students. Young specialists must have not only a sufficiently high level of theoretical training but also, first of all, practical training. It is wonderful that our experience in filling production workshops with tools continued this year. Drills, screwdrivers, soldering irons, hammers, nails, screwdrivers, calipers, welding machines, wrenches, jigsaws and many other new and used items were received from Germany by the Skvira High Vocational School and the Tarashchansky College of Economics and Law. Sewing machines, overlocks, accessories and fabrics were transferred to the Kyiv Vocational College of Technology and Design. The implementation of this project was made possible thanks to our loyal friends from Germany "Sai Care Stiftung". The students of the Nizhyn College of Culture and Arts have their own production practice because they are future musicians, singers and choreographers. Therefore, in addition to the synthesizer and saxophone donated by our benefactors, concert outfits were purchased for young people.



SOCIO-EDUCATIONAL PROJECT "EDUCATIONAL HUB"



War is a factor in many children's suffering. Military fightings, loss of loved ones, forced displacement - all of these are traumatic events that do not pass without consequences for the human psyche. This period is especially difficult for teenagers who are graduating from school and taking their first steps into independent life. Unfortunately, today the world is dangerous for Ukrainian teenagers, the war does not give them the opportunity to look confidently into the future.

Instability and danger have a negative impact on children and lead to a deterioration in their educational opportunities. War fundamentally affects the quality of education. It is also important to pay attention to the

psychological state of students which significantly affects the ability to learn. Children are noticeably anxious and worried, lack of motivation to learn, in particular apathy and indifference, as well as confusion and inattention.

Therefore, the relevance of the "Educational HUB" project in the conditions of a country that defends its freedom and right to the future is undeniable. "Educational HUB" provides comprehensive support for families with teenagers who live in the territory of de-occupied, occupied and frontline communities of Ukraine or have left these territories, as well as support for teenagers who have lost one or both parents as a result of the Russian war in Ukraine. These teenagers are school graduates (finishing the 11th grade) and plan to enter educational institutions of Ukraine (obtaining professional pre-higher and higher education).

Project goal is helping graduates of schools of the above categories in wartime conditions to prepare well for admission to educational institutions in Ukraine and ensuring their equal access to quality education.

The "Educational HUB" Project in the 2023-2024 academic year covered:

- 6 (six) deoccupied and frontline communities in the territory of the Kherson region, namely: Novovorontsovka settlement territorial community, Novooleksandrivka rural territorial community, Vysokopil'ska settlement territorial community, Mylivka rural united territorial community; Beryslavska urban territorial community, Velykooleksandrivka settlement territorial community;
- 1 (one) front-line community of the Kharkiv region: Chuhuyiv city territorial community.

One teenager from the occupied territories of the Kherson region also participated in the project.

In addition, the detdom.info team has begun fruitful cooperation with the Children of Heroes Charity Foundation. The Children of Heroes Foundation provides long-term assistance to children who have lost one or both parents as a result of the Russian war in Ukraine.



Groups of students were formed to conduct online classes to prepare for the National Multi-Subject Test (NMT) in the following subjects:

Thus, at the beginning of the educational process, a total of 55 project participants were studying in courses in various subjects, covering 67 student places. At the end of the educational process, there were 44 participants, covering 56 student slots. 80% of the participants were able to complete the educational process.

The contractor FASTFORWARD LLC (educational company ZNO.UA) was engaged to conduct online courses for children. Classes were conducted on the company's platform by qualified and experienced teachers.

Project results:

Mathematics: 46.2% of students increased their rating by more than 20

points at the end of the mathematics course (6 out of 13 students). The maximum increase of the result is +47 points.

One of the participants of the "Educational Hub" was in the occupied territory and did not have the opportunity to take the NMT, according to the established rules for taking the NMT. For Vladyslav, participation in the project was extremely important, as it helped him feel a sense of belonging to the Ukrainian educational environment and receive emotional support from peers and adults. The young man applied to one of the higher educational institutions in the Kherson region for the specialty "Computer Science" and successfully joined him.

Ukrainian language: 41.7% of students improved their rating by the end of the Ukrainian language course, almost 20 points or more (5 out of 12 students). Maximum increase of the result is +32 points.

History of Ukraine: 32.3% of students increased their rating by almost 20 points or more at the end of their studies in the history of Ukraine course (10 out of 31 students). The maximum increase of the result is +56 points.

Analysis of the project results, as well as surveys of children, parents, and teachers, provide grounds to assess the results of the project implementation as "good." The children received the necessary knowledge within their level and emotional state.

85% of participants (out of 44 children) who completed the courses entered higher educational institutions in Ukraine.

"I WANT TO LEARN" PROJECT

"I Want to Learn" Project helps children from family-type orphanages to better master basic school subjects through additional individual lessons with tutors.

According to the final data of the educational resource for 2024, there are many problems among Ukrainian schools, especially those located far from district centers. After all, with the beginning of war hostilities teachers did not undergo state retraining the educational material is still taught according to "old" standards and methods. As a result, students who attend only school classes do not receive the necessary knowledge and cannot pass the upcoming NMT and ZNO at a decent level.

And for orphans, psychological and everyday moments of adaptation to a new foster family or to a family-type orphanage are also acute. Getting into a family-type orphanage from an institution or from a family where the parents neglected their direct duties, the child needs additional attention from parents-educators, teachers, and social services. After all, the level of knowledge of children from an orphan institutions is usually lower than that of their peers.

"I Want to Learn" Project has been successfully operating since 2020 to this day.

Over the last academic year, the project has been reformatted and the focus group of participants has been narrowed to those who need it most: children - future school graduates (9th, 10th, and 11th grades) and children who have just been placed in foster families or in DBST.

During the project, it has been proven that future applicants to universities are the most motivated category of students, they already understand why they need to study, why they need to strive to gain knowledge and pass tests better.

Of course, anxiety and illness make adjustments and in order not to miss classes tutors conduct online classes for our children. But, as practice shows, distance learning is good but the best knowledge is transmitted only in a face-to-face format. And online learning is somewhat demotivating for the student because you can both peek and copy the assignment, but in person, in the presence of a demanding teacher, this is impossible!

Therefore, it is extracurricular learning with individual contact between the child and the teacher that increases the level of knowledge in the most complex areas of the disciplines, since the teacher pays 100% of his attention to the student. The teacher can individually answer all questions and allocate as much time to master the material as the child needs. Therefore, we focus on the offline format.

In the 2nd semester of the 2023-2024 academic year, 9 DBSTs (50 children) from different parts of Ukraine participated in the project "I Want to Learn". The children studied subjects such as Ukrainian, English, mathematics and history. Particular attention was paid to children who had recently entered DBSTs and children who were preparing to take the NMT and enter universities and colleges.

In January 2024 everyone's knowledge level was recorded and in June the children were tested again. The results of the test sections showed that the children's knowledge improved by an average of 1-2 points, and in some cases by 3-4.

At the beginning of 2023, new children were placed in the Zherebchenko DBST by state authorities. The children had psychological trauma and visible developmental delays. Thanks to classes with a tutor, Rostik, a 4th grade student, lost his fear of the teacher, he believed in himself and realized that he could learn. And Vlad, who is 6 years old, did not speak, had the development level of a two-year-old child. The annual results with the tutor are amazing. Now Vlad can count, read, and, most importantly, he learned to talk about his feelings and share the events that happened to him during the day. According to his mother Olena, this is invaluable.



At DBST Peresenchuk, the children in care were catching up on their knowledge of mathematics. Teacher Yegor Mykolayovych decided to experiment with a practical homework assignment: to use grams, percentages and discounts in a grocery store when shopping for groceries for the family. "We agreed with the mother-educator to give the children the following tasks: student Olya had to buy meat dishes for dinner for the whole family, taking into account discounts, high quality, and the approximate consumption of each family member in grams. Victoria and Liza had to buy a salad and a side dish and Yaroslav a gift for his father. At the same time, each child was given individual funds. And another task: in addition to the above purchases each child could buy something for themselves, but for no more than 20% of the funds received." The children were delighted with such practical calculations and such mathematics. They coped with the task 100%.

In the new academic year, starting from the 1st semester of 2024-2025, 27 children from 11 family-type orphanages are participating.

Despite the fact that additional classes started on October 1, 2024, by the end of December we already had good results - knowledge has improved by at least 1-2 points.

In the Solomakh DBST, since November, two children have been placed at once, who were redirected to them from another region. The children have poor writing skills in the Ukrainian language, so starting in November they have been actively working with tutors. In two months, progress is already noticeable.

Reviews:

- Tetyana Feliksvna, English teacher (Dzyuba State Secondary Educational Service): "For 11th grade students, such as Kateryna, such additional education is extremely necessary, because the additional knowledge obtained gives a chance to enter a university not only in Ukraine but also in any European country. Knowledge of English provides the opportunity to listen to lectures and master classes of English-speaking teachers to obtain useful information for yourself from world resources. Kateryna's progress was felt literally in the second month of classes. Thank you very much!"

"FAMILY NEEDS HELP" PROGRAM



Oxana F. family got food donation from us

The family is the first social institution in a child's life and an important factor in their successful socialization in the future. However, sometimes families find themselves in difficult life situations that may threaten their existence. It is such families that are taken care of by detdom.info team. In addition, large families and professional families (family-type children's homes, families of guardians) are constantly under our close watch. The full-scale war of Russia against Ukraine, which began on February 24, 2022, interrupted the natural process of life and development of the Ukrainian family, changed the conditions of its life, exacerbated existing problems and provoked new problems and risks. The poverty of a certain part of Ukrainian families was a problem of Ukraine in the pre-war years, and with the advent of the war, the

scale of poverty doubled. If in 2021, 43.2% of households with children were in the poor category, then in 2022 their share increased to 65.2%, and in 2023 - to 65.6%. Therefore, this project is extremely important in the modern realities of life during the war! One of the areas of our work is to provide such families with food, hygiene products, warm clothes, power banks, flashlights, generators and charging stations. This allows us to improve their lives, reduce stress and psychological trauma, and, accordingly, strengthen the family.

In the summer, Ms. Angelika Berger from Germany, who is an active volunteer of the Sai Care Stiftung Foundation, personally visited Kyiv to hand over generators and charging stations to family-type orphanages. Also, this year, interesting projects were:

- providing household appliances (refrigerators, washing machines and dryers, freezers, etc.) to DBST, implemented thanks to our partners "VLUZH All-Ukrainian League of Ukrainian Women";

- to provide families with medical supplies and first aid kits, in which funding was provided by employees of the Canadian company "Progressive Automatijs".



They did not forget about the families who managed to leave the occupation. Oksana S.'s family escaped from the occupation in the spring of 2024. The horrors they experienced are hard to describe. After what they experienced, Oksana's daughter-in-law had a severe nervous breakdown, her eldest grandson developed enuresis and the woman herself was diagnosed with diabetes. Oksana's husband served in the Armed Forces of Ukraine and has been missing since April 2022. A few days after their departure, the occupiers came to their home and burned everything. The woman is very glad that she and her son's family managed to be in controlled territory at this time.

During 2024, our team provided assistance to 131 families raising 715 children.

Mentoring



detdom.info coordinators at "Dialog" meeting

One of the effective areas of assistance to orphans is mentoring. Unfortunately, the Covid pandemic and war made its adjustments and the attention of socially active people was diverted to other tasks and goals. Military operations continue today and Ukrainian children, as before, are growing up in boarding schools without proper support from a trusted adult person. On September 20-21, the event "United by Mentoring" was held in Lviv. Organizations and foundations from different parts of Ukraine gathered for a dialogue on the revival of the project and improving its implementation. The coordinators of detdom.info have extensive experience in

mentoring and are among the best trainers. Participation in the dialogue inspired us to resume activities in this area.

Visiting children

Despite the difficulties and the state of war a group of volunteers from the Kmytivka boarding school does not stop their trips to the children. In 2024, as always, the volunteers visited their wards systematically and regularly. They spent time with the children, taught them to be friends, respect each other, take care of themselves and others and did not forget that it is important to provide skills for integrating boarding school graduates into our society. At the end of 2024, the first trip during the war of a group of volunteers from the Kyiv Multiplex cinemas to the Hadyatsky Center for Social and Psychological Rehabilitation (Hadyatsky Orphanage) also took place. We hope that a strong friendship will be established between the volunteers and the children and in the report for 2025 we will tell about interesting moments and the active work of the volunteers.

Summer camp - island of safety

The summer of 2024 became the 3rd summer of a full-scale war that changed our entire usual life. However, it is precisely because of this, children who have lived and studied all year round in conditions of constant air raids, missile attacks and power outages should have a good rest in the summer, gain strength and improve their health and at least a little distract themselves from the disturbing news. Positive memories of fun summer adventures help children find joy and feel safe and happy. 2 boys from the Nazarenko family-type orphanage received wonderful summer impressions from a vacation in a camp in the Kyiv region (Pushcha-Vodytsia) and the international charitable foundation "Help Us Help UA" invited not only the children but also the mother-teacher of our ward DBST Molyar to the Carpathian camp.

Support to orphanages

Back in 2014 detdom.info volunteers visited the Hadyatskyi orphanage for the first time and have been communicating with the children and graduates since then. Many of the institution's graduates are now in the ranks of the Armed Forces of Ukraine and were participants in the "Our Defenders" project, some were participants in our other projects, such as "Successful Start" and "My Friend" mentoring project. Therefore, it is always nice to help old friends. In the spring, a lawnmower was purchased for the institution. Now the large area adjacent to the building has been landscaped and children have the opportunity to spend their leisure time there.
